Named the Mashonaland Herald, the newspaper was launched by [William Fairbridge](#) in 1891 for the [Argus Group](#) of South Africa.^[1] After the country attained independence, the government bought the paper from the Argus group. In October 1982 the paper changed its name to Rhodesian Herald.

Its first black editor was [Willie Musarurwa](#).
